Directions to 425 NE 95th St.

From the North

Take I-5 south towards downtown Seattle to Exit 173. Go east on Northgate Way, past Northgate Mall to 5th Avenue NE (Key Bank is at corner). Turn right and continue south about 3/4 mile to NE 95th Street. Our Church is on the right, on the corner.

From the South

Take I-5 north from downtown Seattle to Exit 173. At end of ramp turn right on First Avenue NE. Go South to first traffic light at NE 103rd Street and turn left. Proceed to traffic light at Fifth Avenue NE, turn right and continue south about 0.4 miles to NE 95th Street. The Church is on the right, on the corner.
