Advent Reading ~ Psalm 98:4, 7-9

- **4** Make a joyful noise to the LORD, all the earth; break forth into joyous song and sing praises!
- 7 Let the sea roar, and all that fills it; the world and those who dwell in it!
- 8 Let the rivers clap their hands; let the hills sing for joy together
- **9** before the LORD, for he comes to judge the earth. He will judge the world with righteousness, and the peoples with equity

Advent Candle (Joy)

Reader: [Light Candle] Christ defied the darkness of a world full of sadness by coming into it to restore his people to joy.

All: We, like he did, walk through valleys of sadness. But we also, like him, defy the darkness by lighting this candle which represents the joy he gives us.

Scripture Reading ~ Luke 1:39-56

39 In those days Mary arose and went with haste into the hill country, to a town in Judah, **40** and she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth. **41** And when Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, the baby leaped in her womb. And Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit, **42** and she exclaimed with a loud cry, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb! **43** And why is this granted to me that the mother of my Lord should come to me? **44** For behold, when the sound of your greeting came to my ears, the baby in my womb leaped for joy. **45** And blessed is she who believed that there would be a fulfillment of what was spoken to her from the Lord."

- 46 And Mary said, "My soul magnifies the Lord,
- 47 and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior,
- **48** for he has looked on the humble estate of his servant. For behold, from now on all generations will call me blessed;

- 49 for he who is mighty has done great things for me, and holy is his name.
- **50** And his mercy is for those who fear him from generation to generation.
- **51** He has shown strength with his arm; he has scattered the proud in the thoughts of their hearts;
- **52** he has brought down the mighty from their thrones and exalted those of humble estate;
- **53** he has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich he has sent away empty.
- 54 He has helped his servant Israel, in remembrance of his mercy,
- 55 as he spoke to our fathers, to Abraham and to his offspring forever."
- **56** And Mary remained with her about three months and returned to her home.

Hearing the Word Together

Sermon Passage ~ 1 Peter 1:3-12

3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, 4 to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, 5 who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. 6 In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials, 7 so that the tested genuineness of your faith—more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ. 8 Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory, 9 obtaining the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls.

10 Concerning this salvation, the prophets who prophesied about the grace that was to be yours searched and inquired carefully, **11** inquiring what person or time the Spirit of Christ in them was indicating when he predicted the sufferings of Christ and the subsequent glories. **12** It was revealed to them that they were serving not themselves but you, in the things that have now been announced to you through those who preached the good news to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven, things into which angels long to look.
